4 New Features

4.1 CYBER ASD and CSSP I/DD Waiver Updates System Scope

The current waiver programs are being updated with changes in the requirements for the following areas:

- New Service codes are added to the Service Codes covered by the ASD and CSSP I/DD waiver lists: Service code 96152HA (IIH-Behavioral Consultative Services (BCS) (Doctorate Level) and H0031HAHP (Functional Behavior Assessment (BCBA-D) service codes were added to the Service Codes covered by ASD Waiver and service codes covered by the CSSP I/DD.
- The end date of the CSSP I/DD Waiver SPC 38 segment was updated to the month prior to the youth turning age 21.
- Program Status Code 391 NJ Supplemental Prenatal Care Program, NJ Workability 291 through 294, and 591 through 594 NJ Workability- sliding scale were added as an exclusion to eligibility for the ASD and CSSP I/DD Waivers.

5 Enhancements

The following enhancements are included in this release.

WO 309370 FB 29557	REQUEST: Add a grace period of 3 calendar days, aka 72 hours, for the user to log in and reset their password after their account is reactivated in CYBER when they were deactivated via 180 day deactivation job and locked out via 90 day lockout job. RESOLUTION: User now has three days to log in and reset password after account is reactivated.
WO 299253 FB 29544	REQUEST: DCP&P (DYFS) users must be able to see the EXE users (CSOC /SRTU consultant) on the provider tab of the face sheet of the youth's record. EXE users can be added

	<p>to the Youth's record by logging in as EXE user-select agency type-click on add provider button-choose existing provider from the drop down-pick start date and click on accept..</p> <p>RESOLUTION: DCP&P users are able to see EXE (CSOC/SRTU) users on the provider tab.</p>
<p>WO 309205 FB 29568</p>	<p>REQUEST: FSS APP Text change request in caregiver tab.</p> <p>RESOLUTION: Text 'Compensated caregiver' is now replaced by 'Resource Family'. All existing approved apps still shows 'Compensated caregiver' selected option. This text change will only reflect on new FSS Apps.</p>

6 Defect Fixes

<p>WO 308915 FB 29560</p>	<p>ISSUE: CYBER Security Administrator displayed on the Welcome Page. CSA System Admin user would just enter a space before the phone number and save, and that security admin name would show but since we started trimming the spaces in phone and email fields from last release, they are no longer able to do that. Need this functionality to revert.</p> <p>RESOLUTION: The system now saves the space in the phone number field and user is able to view that Security Administrators name on the agency users welcome page.</p>
<p>WO 309026 FB 29551</p>	<p>ISSUE: Initial ICP submitted by MRSS was AutoApproved by CSA and then submitted to PC again the same day. This happen because two users had the treatment plan open at the same time and submitted one after the other.</p> <p>RESOLUTION: Now there will be a validation in place when a user tries to submit a plan to CSA. The validation is to check whether the plan is already submitted and approved.</p>
<p>WO 278599 FB 27658</p>	<p>ISSUE: TX PLANS: NOTEPAD entries sorted Out of Order.</p> <p>RESOLUTION: Notepad grid sort order is being corrected now.</p>
<p>WO 309712 FB 29559</p>	<p>ISSUE: BPS Text Return Data - issue with the youth survey campaign opt out – it appears 100% of the records for this campaign are unprocessed (with the exception of one from February).</p> <p>RESOLUTION: The script was modified and will update the opt out selection in CYBER.</p>

WO 309503 FB 29556	ISSUE: Call Resolution: calls include a resolution of DD/ID-FAMILY SUPPORT APPLICATION REFERRAL though there are resolved with AHH referral and youth checklist. RESOLUTION: Wrong resolution code for the call has been fixed.
WO 309105 FB 29663	ISSUE: CSOC- White Screen issue while resetting the password. RESOLUTION: It seems that the reset password screen is using a font type that is not installed on some of the user's computers. Font type for this screen is corrected now.
