FB 14315 WO 126879 WO 233490	Issue: OOH users can submit the JCR directly to the CSA without sending the Treatment Plan to the open CMO Agency for review. Resolved: The hierarchy for the JCR Treatment Plans is working as expected and are sent to the CMO prior to being sent to the CSA for review.
FB 25811 WO 233984	Issue: When a user creates and Episode for an OOH Admission the Add/Edit Admissions data does not match what is displayed in the Episodes grid of the youth's record. Resolved: The Episodes grid and Add/Edit Admissions screen are displaying the same data as expected.
