## 4 New Features

### 4.1 DB 12.0.0 ICD 10 Updates

The ICD-10 code changes affect both the medical and behavioral health diagnoses that are available for selection in a youth's record in CYBER. The following is a recap of the number of changes that will be made.

- 279 new ICD-10 codes have been added
- 51 existing codes have been deleted
- 143 codes have been revised

The diagnosis changes apply to the following areas of CYBER where a diagnosis can be entered:

- Youth's FaceSheet
- Needs Assessment
- BPS Assessment
- CAT Assessment
- BHH Nursing Assessments
- OOH Assessment
- CMO/UCM Treatment Plans
- IIC BA Treatment Plans
- IIH Treatment Plans
- MRSS Treatment Plans
- OOH Treatment Plans
- Substance Use Treatment Plans

- UM Forms
- Claims/1500 Forms

The following table lists the changes to the behavioral health codes for the ICD-10 update.

- Deleted Codes:
  - None
- Revised Codes (description has changed)
  - F53 Puerperal psychosis  
F53 is now Mental and behavioral disorders associated with the puerperium, not elsewhere classified
  - F68.1 Factitious disorder  
F68.1 is now Factitious disorder imposed on self
  - F68.10 Factitious disorder, unspecified  
F68.10 is now Factitious disorder imposed on self, unspecified
  - F68.11 Factitious disorder with predominantly psychological signs and symptoms  
F68.11 is now Factitious disorder imposed on self, with predominantly psychological signs and symptoms
  - F68.12 Factitious disorder with predominantly physical signs and symptoms  
F68.12 is now Factitious disorder imposed on self, with predominantly physical signs and symptoms
  - F68.13 Factitious disorder with combined psychological and physical signs and symptoms  
F68.13 is now Factitious disorder imposed on self, with combined psychological and physical signs and symptoms
- Added Codes:
  - F12.23 – Cannabis dependence with withdrawal
  - F12.93 – Cannabis use, unspecified with withdrawal
  - F53.0 – Postpartum depression
  - F53.1 – Puerperal psychosis
  - F68.A – Factitious disorder imposed on another

## 5 Defect Fixes

The following items were fixed and have been included in this release.

<b>FogBugz #/ Work Order #</b>	<b>Description</b>
FB 26841 WO 252694	ISSUE: When there is no active youth on 'My Active Youth' - the warning message uses the word 'caseload' RESOLVED: The warning message now states, ""There are no youth in your Active Youth list" when the user has no active Provider tab entries added with their userid.
FB 26674 WO 256328	ISSUE: SAB user cannot create a SNA when user and youth open to multiple programs simultaneously. User receives a view of the "Choose Program" pink screen and receives an error when selecting a program and clicking ACCEPT. RESOLVED: Users open to multiple programs with youth open to multiple programs no longer receive an error when selecting and accepting a program for the SNA or any other assessment type.
FB 26706	ISSUE: There was a "back door" which allows a read-only Annex A user to create and or modify an Annex A Addendum. RESOLVED: Annex A Administrators with Read-Only security are no longer able to access the create or modification buttons in the Annex A grid view.
FB 26732 WO 257865	ISSUE: Users with access to CLAIMS data cannot export this data in CYBER. RESOLVED: Users are again able to export the data as long as the user has security which allows access to this claims data.
FB 26849 WO 257864	ISSUE: When the CSA enters a FAMILY entry on the DEMOGRAPHICS page and the ZIPCODE calls multiple CITY/COUNTY combinations and the CSA selects one that is not the first option in the database, the CITY gets changed to be the first option in CYBER. RESOLVED: The selected CITY/COUNTY combination remains as selected on SAVE and all future updates unless purposely changed.
FB 26774 WO 258551	ISSUE: The email address for SRTU populates in the UMSR form with the old address (SRTUConsultation@dcf.state.nj.us). RESOLVED: The template for the UMSR has been updated to the current SRTU email address, <a href="mailto:SRTUConsultation@dcf.nj.gov">SRTUConsultation@dcf.nj.gov</a> .
